Departments work collaboratively with their Head of Department to standardise grades and ranks for entire cohorts to ensure grades and orders are accurate and fair.

SLT hold meetings with Heads of Department to analyse and check results and ranks. Results are justified from the evidence used.

Whole school standardisation and checking of results and ranks.

Clerical checks of all data to ensure no errors.

Centre assessed grades and ranks are submitted to the exam boards.

Final clerical checks take place before Mr Coen signs off the uploads.

Exam boards and Ofqual will look at historical data and make adjustments to centre assessed grades as necessary to ensure no students are neither advantaged or disadvantaged. Ranks will not be altered.

A Level results will be available 13th August

GCSE results will be available 20<sup>th</sup> August.
