Further to my letter in November sharing news of our recognition among the best secondary schools in East Anglia, I am now pleased to share further accolades for the school.

Our GCSE Progress 8 figure, the progress made by students throughout their time with us and a significant inspection measure for schools, places us 19th out of 130 Essex schools. This also confirms our place in the top 10% of schools nationally for A Level, maintaining our record of outstanding provision, independently recognised by ALPS national A Level progress data.
